Background Knowledge for the Teacher:

Shahnameh

The Shahnameh is a book of Kings written a long time ago.

o The Shahnameh was written by a man named Ferdowsi

The Shahnameh is one of the world's longest poems.

It has over 60,000 verses

o The Shahnameh was written in Persian

- o The Shahnameh tells the stories of kings and heroes from a long time ago
- The Shahnameh tells us about the traditions of Sadeh, Nowruz, and Mehregan

Ferdowsi

- Ferdowsi wrote the Shahnameh.
- He is a Persian poet
- Ferdowsi was born 1,000 years ago in Toos, Iran.
- o It took him 33 years to write the whole Shahnameh
- May 15th is National Ferdowsi Day in Iran
 - There are art and cultural festivals held across the country
- The king asked Ferdowsi to write down the history of Persia
- King Keyumars
- King Hushang
- King Tahmuras

Lesson for students:

The teacher will use the information in the "Background Knowledge for the Teacher" section to review what students remember about the Shahnameh from the Pre-K to K lesson plans. Teachers can use the information above to just review information or can put information into a review game.

Activity for Students:
