### **CHOOSE TIMINGS & FREQUENCY**

 Determine the schedule for the classes, availability and convenience by gathering info from the community through a survey

## **SELECT A VENUE**

 Find a suitable location within the center to conduct the classes making sure it can accommodate participants





## **RECRUIT & TRAIN TEACHERS**

- Recruit teachers who are passionate about sharing religious education.
- Provide training and resources to enhance their skills and knowledge.

### PROMOTE THE CLASSES

 Use various channels like social media, newsletter, community meetings. to promote the classes.





#### LAUNCH PILOT CLASSES

- Host a kickoff event to introduce the Ed. Committee and the religion classes
- Start the classes according to the schedule.
