

# STARTING AN EDUCATION COMMITTEE

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## RESEARCH AND PLAN

- Identify your target audience (e.g. children, adults, youth, etc.)
- Familiarize yourself with the religious teachings, beliefs, etc.)

## FORM A DEDICATED TEAM

- Gather a team of passionate individuals committed to promoting religious education.
- Assign roles and responsibilities, such as coordinator, teachers, and Admin support.

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## DEFINE THE MISSION

- Write a clear and concise mission statement for your Ed. Committee, stating its purpose and value.

## CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

- Develop a comprehensive curriculum that covers key teachings, traditions and other aspects of the religion.

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## CHOOSE TIMINGS & FREQUENCY

- Determine the schedule for the classes, availability and convenience by gathering info from the community through a survey

## SELECT A VENUE

- Find a suitable location within the center to conduct the classes making sure it can accommodate participants

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## RECRUIT & TRAIN TEACHERS

- Recruit teachers who are passionate about sharing religious education.
- Provide training and resources to enhance their skills and knowledge.

## PROMOTE THE CLASSES

- Use various channels like social media, newsletter, community meetings. to promote the classes.

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## LAUNCH PILOT CLASSES

- Host a kickoff event to introduce the Ed. Committee and the religion classes
- Start the classes according to the schedule.

## GATHER FEEDBACK & IMPROVE

- Regularly seek feedback through surveys from teachers, students and the community.

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
