Dear Reader

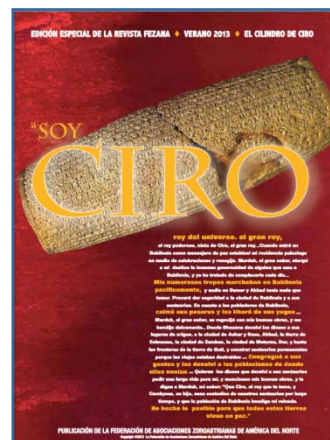

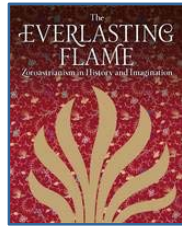
## Activities Report from FIRES

### **FIRES – Voted For A Standing Committee**

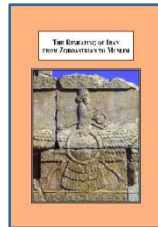

Shahnaz Sidhwa very generously donated half the proceeds to the ZAH library. The committee is immensely grateful for this magnanimous gesture. □



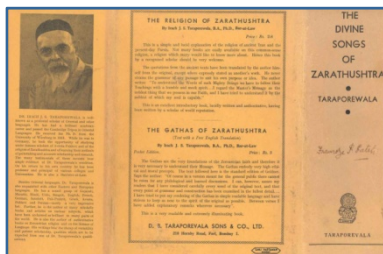
## ACHIEVEMENTS
